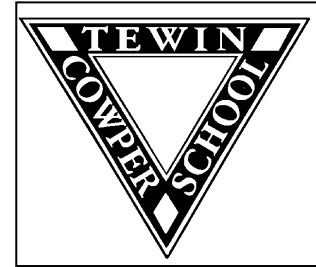

THE SCHOOL WILL SEEK TO:

1. Care for your child's safety and happiness,
2. Ensure your child reaches their full potential and is a valued member of the school,
3. Provide a broad, balanced curriculum to meet the individual needs of your child and prepare them for the future,
4. Encourage your child to achieve high standards of work, presentation and behaviour.
5. Build good relationships and develop a sense of responsibility based on Christian values.
6. Keep you informed about general school matters, educational issues and your child's progress.
7. Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school.

THE PARENTS / CARERS I/WE WILL SEEK TO:

1. Ensure that my/our child goes to school regularly, punctually and properly equipped. In the event of absence, contact the school as soon as possible and then provide a note of explanation.
2. Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's work or behaviour.
3. Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and homework*.
4. Support the child's learning to help them achieve their full potential.
5. Attend parent consultations and discussions about my/our child's progress, valuing experience and expertise of the staff.
6. Support and value the school (for example by attending meetings, open sessions, fund raising).
7. Adhere to the Travel Plan*.
8. Ensure I/we are familiar with the e-safety policies of the school and adhere to the rules for internet safety*.
9. Not upload photographs / videos taken at school events onto any social networking sites or the internet.

THE PUPIL I WILL SEEK TO:

1. Arrive at school on time.
2. Wear my uniform with pride.
3. Show politeness, kindness and respect for all.
4. Work as a team.
5. Show controlled behaviour in lessons and assemblies.
6. Show respect for my own and others' property.
7. Use the dining room quietly and eat sensibly.
8. Use only designated areas for playing.
9. Keep my classroom and desk tidy.
10. Move around the building quietly and with consideration for others.
11. Take responsibility for my own actions/behaviour and 'put things right'
